

## Digital Networks Application End User Licence Agreement (EULA)

Last Updated: 11/03/2026

This Digital Networks Application End User Licence Agreement (“Licence Agreement”) governs your access to and use of the Digital Networks application and related software services.

Digital Networks is operated by Dikotla Originals (Pty) Ltd (“Digital Networks”, “we”, “us”, or “our”).

Please read this Licence Agreement carefully before downloading or using the Digital Networks application.

### 1. Your Use of the Digital Networks App Creates an Agreement

1.1 Digital Networks provides an on-demand digital streaming service through which users may stream audiovisual productions including digital theatre productions, dramatic works, cultural performances, educational media, and related audiovisual content (“Content”).

1.2 The Digital Networks service may be accessed through compatible internet-enabled devices including personal computers, smartphones, tablets, smart televisions, media players, gaming consoles, and other connected devices (“Access Devices”).

1.3 To enable access to the service, Digital Networks provides a software application and related documentation (“Digital Networks App”).

1.4 The following documents form part of this Licence Agreement and are incorporated by reference:

- Digital Networks Terms of Use
- Digital Networks Privacy Policy
- Digital Networks Cookie Policy

1.5 By downloading, installing, accessing, or using the Digital Networks App, you agree to be bound by this Licence Agreement.

1.6 If you do not agree to this Licence Agreement, you must not download, install, access, or use the Digital Networks App.

1.7 The Digital Networks App is licensed to you, not sold. All ownership rights remain with Digital Networks and its licensors.

### 2. Accessing the Digital Networks App

2.1 To access the Digital Networks App you must have a compatible Access Device.

2.2 Your Access Device must meet the minimum technical specifications published by Digital Networks.

2.3 You are responsible for obtaining and maintaining:

- internet connectivity

- telecommunications services
- compatible hardware and software

2.4 Digital Networks is not responsible for internet access charges, telecommunications fees, or device limitations.

2.5 If the Access Device does not belong to you, you confirm that you have permission from the owner to install and use the Digital Networks App.

### 3. Grant of Licence

3.1 Subject to compliance with this Licence Agreement, Digital Networks grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable licence to download, install, and use the Digital Networks App for personal, non-commercial use.

3.2 This licence allows you to access Digital Networks Content solely through the Digital Networks platform.

3.3 No rights are granted to access the source code of the Digital Networks App.

### 4. Licence Restrictions

Except where permitted by law, you may not:

- 4.1 copy, reproduce, distribute, or modify the Digital Networks App.
- 4.2 sell, lease, sublicense, or commercially exploit the Digital Networks App.
- 4.3 reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the application.
- 4.4 bypass platform security measures or digital rights management protections.
- 4.5 attempt to extract, copy, or redistribute Content.
- 4.6 use the Digital Networks platform to develop competing services.
- 4.7 introduce malware, viruses, or harmful code.
- 4.8 harvest or collect platform data without authorization.
- 4.9 use the platform for unlawful or fraudulent purposes.

### 5. Content Licence and Viewing Rights

5.1 Digital Networks provides licensed access to audiovisual productions available through the platform.

5.2 Content is licensed for streaming access only and remains the property of Digital Networks or its licensors.

5.3 Digital Networks may offer multiple access models including:

## Watch Once Access

Users may purchase temporary streaming access to a specific title.

### 5.4 Watch Once access:

- is limited
- expires within 24 hours from the time of purchase
- is non-transferable

### 5.5 Watch Once access does not include:

- multilingual subtitle features
- audio dubbing features
- educational support materials

## 5.6 Subscription Access

Digital Networks may offer subscription plans that provide broader platform access including:

- multilingual subtitles
- audio dubbing across South African languages
- learner-teacher discussion resources
- educational study tools
- unlimited streaming during the subscription period.

## 6. Anti-Recording and Screen Capture Restrictions

6.1 Content available on Digital Networks is protected by copyright and digital rights management technologies.

6.2 Users may not record, reproduce, or capture Content streamed through the platform.

6.3 Users must not:

- screen-record Content
- capture screenshots of Content
- record audio from streamed Content
- redistribute Content on other platforms.

6.4 Any attempt to circumvent platform protections is strictly prohibited.

6.5 Digital Networks reserves the right to suspend or terminate accounts involved in unauthorized recording or redistribution of Content.

## 7. Account Use and Household Access

7.1 Digital Networks accounts are intended for personal use.

7.2 Accounts may be used across multiple devices within a household environment.

7.3 Users may not:

- sell account access
- share login credentials for commercial use
- distribute account access beyond reasonable personal use.

7.4 Digital Networks may monitor account usage for unusual activity.

7.5 Accounts found to be abused may be restricted, suspended, or terminated.

## 8. Institutional and Classroom Streaming Licence

8.1 Digital Networks Content may be used in educational environments subject to applicable licensing.

8.2 Individual licences do not automatically grant rights for institutional screening.

8.3 Schools, educators, and institutions may use Digital Networks Content where:

- the Content is streamed directly through the platform
- access is obtained through an authorised licence or subscription
- the Content is used for educational purposes.

8.4 Educational institutions may not:

- download or distribute Content outside the platform
- copy or reproduce productions for physical distribution
- screen Content publicly without appropriate licensing.

## 9. Digital Rights Management (DRM) and Security

9.1 Digital Networks uses digital rights management technologies and encryption systems to protect Content.

9.2 Users may not bypass, disable, or interfere with these security systems.

9.3 Users may not use automated tools, scraping software, or stream-ripping tools to access Content.

9.4 Attempts to circumvent security protections may result in immediate suspension of platform access.

## 10. Content Availability and Catalogue Rotation

10.1 The Digital Networks catalogue may change from time to time.

10.2 Digital Networks may:

- add new titles
- remove titles
- rotate productions within the catalogue.

10.3 Digital Networks does not guarantee permanent availability of any specific title.

10.4 Where users purchase Watch Once access, access will remain available for the purchased viewing window even if the title is later removed from the catalogue.

## 11. Changes to the App and Service

11.1 Digital Networks may update or modify the application at any time.

11.2 Updates may include:

- security improvements
- new features
- performance improvements.

11.3 Continued use of the Digital Networks App after updates constitutes acceptance of the updated version.

## 12. Suspension or Termination

Digital Networks may suspend or terminate access to the platform if:

- licence restrictions are violated
- piracy is detected
- fraudulent activity occurs
- required by law.

## 13. Intellectual Property

13.1 All intellectual property rights in the Digital Networks platform and Content are owned by Digital Networks or its licensors.

13.2 Users receive a limited licence to stream Content only.

13.3 No ownership rights in any Content are transferred to users.

## 14. Data Collection

Digital Networks may collect information including:

- device information
- usage data
- streaming analytics
- technical performance data.

Personal information is processed in accordance with the Digital Networks Privacy Policy and POPIA.

## 15. Disclaimers and Limitation of Liability

15.1 The Digital Networks platform is provided “as is” and “as available”.

15.2 Digital Networks does not guarantee uninterrupted service.

15.3 Digital Networks is not liable for:

- internet connectivity issues
- device compatibility issues
- data loss
- service interruptions.

## 16. Termination by Users

Users may terminate this Agreement at any time by:

- uninstalling the Digital Networks App
- discontinuing platform use.

## 17. Notices

Digital Networks may communicate notices via:

- email
- platform notifications
- website announcements.
